To help businesses realize energy savings, the Energy Management Co-op Program offers four workshops throughout the work term, and they are available to both you and your co-op student.

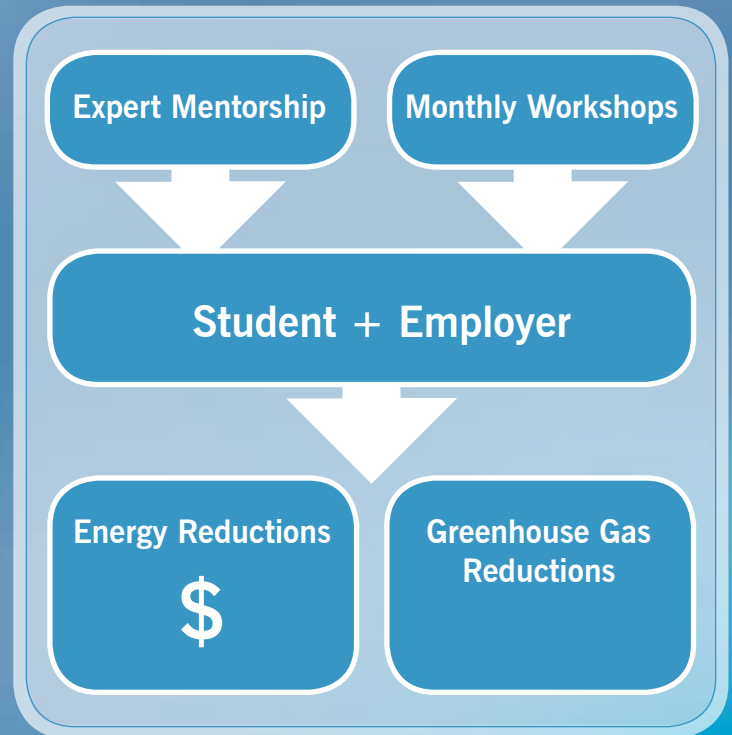
1. Identify energy efficiency opportunities and financial support;
