## Pearson airport to get eco-award

Pearson airport will be honoured next month with an environmental award from the North American arm of Airports Council International, recognizing its work on an eco-business program launched last fall. The Toronto hub has become the first airport ever to win the newly created innovative projects award. A council spokeswoman said Pearson had gone "above and beyond" regulatory compliance standards to protect the environment with its Project Green program, which has focused on creating an internationally recognized "eco-business zone" around Pearson. A growing number of businesses involved in the project have been collaborating to reduce energy and resource costs, create "green" jobs, and address daily business challenges in a "green and cost-effective manner," the GTAA said.
